County U/13 to U/19 T&F Championships: 15 of our athletes travelled to Templemore on Saturday and Sunday last for the County T&F Championships. The club brought home a total of 21 medals - 4 gold, 8 silver and 9 bronze. Amongst the individual medals were 4 county titles which were won by Cora Doyle in the 100m sprint, 800m & Long Jump and Niamh Ryan in the 600m (time 1.53). Niamh also finished 4th in both the High Jump and Hurdles. Eoin Troy finished 2nd in three of his events the High Jump, Triple Jump and the Javelin. Katie Tobin finished 2nd in two of her events the 800m and the 1500m. Mairead Blake finished 2nd in both the 800m and Long Jump and finished 3rd in the 100m sprint. Sean Burke finished 2nd in the Javelin, 3rd 600m, 3rd High Jump – (1.30 – PB) and 4th 80m sprint final. Roisin Daly finished 3rd in three of her events Hurdles, 1500m and the Long Jump (3.95) and 4th in the 800m. Patrick Campion finished 3rd in the 80m sprint final. Aidan Ryan finished 3rd in the 800m.
