County U13 – Junior T & F Championships: Day 2 of the County U13 – Junior T & F Championships took place on Sunday last in Templemore amidst glorious sunshine. 13 of our athletes competed bringing home a total of 4 medals which included 2 County Titles. Emma Doyle clinched the 1st of these when she put in a massive performance in the U14 600mts winning the title comfortably with a time of 2.39 and Ciara Cummins followed on in the U16 800mts with another fine display to win a second County Title on the day for her club with a time of 2.23 – well done girls. Niall Walsh was our other medal winner when he too put showed great pace finishing 3rd in the Junior Men's Hurdles Final and also 3rd in the 400m Final – well done Niall.
